

PRE-K OR KINDERGARTNER with Siblings Receiving FREE/REDUCED MEAL BENEFITS

Dear Parent or Guardian,

If your pre-k or kindergarten son/daughter has older brothers/sisters who have been determined eligible for either free or reduced school meals, please provide the name of the siblings and the school they attended last year as well as the current year. Pre-K or kindergarten students may be allowed to eat at the same status during the grace period until their application has been processed. (Previous year benefits must have been in the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System). If your pre-k or kindergartner does not have siblings on the program for either the current year or from the previous school year, they cannot receive benefits until their meal application is processed or until you are notified of eligibility through the Direct Certification Process. If your pre-k or kindergartner was receiving food stamps or TANF benefits from Montgomery County, Tennessee as of June 30 of the current year and you have not received a notice of eligibility based on direct certification – contact the Child Nutrition Department at the Board of Education at (931) 920-7843.

This information must be provided for verification before students will be allowed to take advantage of this benefit.
