Tennessee State Law requires proof of immunizations (shots) and a physical examination for school attendance. During a routine audit of records at school by the School Nurse, your child's records show a deficiency in the area(s) checked below:

- Out-of-State certificates are not acceptable in Tennessee
- Immunizations are recorded on an improper form. A Permanent Tennessee **School** Immunization Certificate (Health Department or Physician) is required.

- The 30 day grace period for physical exams expires on \_\_\_\_\_.

A copy of previous physical exam completed within the past year is acceptable if dated and signed by a physician/nurse practitioner.

Please contact your physician's office or the Health Department immediately in order to address the listed deficiencies. Your child/children may have already had the required immunizations and the school would only need proof on the correct form (Tennessee School Immunization Certificate). Take any records you have at home along with this letter to the physician's office or the Health Department to have records transcribed onto the appropriate form. Return to the school with Attention: School Nurse.
