ACCOMMODATING DCS INVESTIGATIONS

Clarksville-Montgomery County School System (CMCSS) will cooperate fully with the Tennessee Department of Children's Services in their investigations of alleged child abuse. The Department of Children's Services (DCS) is charged with investigating cases of suspected child abuse and conducting all related investigations to include child interviews. Except in cases where school employees are suspected of being the perpetrator, the school is regarded as an appropriate neutral setting for conducting such interviews. Principals and Department Heads will accommodate DCS and law enforcement personnel with regards to student access, records review and interviewing both students and school personnel.
