These sample schedules are meant to be SAMPLES of what a Kindergarten-5th grade student’s schedule might look like. The order and schedule of classes will vary depending on course demands and teacher caseloads within the enrolled school.

12:30-3:00	RTI2 Intervention Reading or Math (when assigned) OR Special Education Intervention <i>Specific Session time will be communicated by teacher/interventionist.</i>

12:00-12:30	Independent Work <i>Work with Learning Mentor to complete assignments</i>
12:30-1:00	Small Group <i>Live Instruction Alternating Between RLA and Math</i>
1:00-3:00	RTI2 Intervention Reading or Math (when assigned) OR Special Education Intervention <i>Specific Session time will be communicated by teacher/interventionist.</i>

SAMPLE SCHEDULES

These schedules are meant to be SAMPLES of what a 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade student’s schedule might look like. Students will need to be available for synchronous instruction for up to 3 hours each day. Students will be required to participate in synchronous instruction on days scheduled by the instructor at the beginning of the semester. On days that synchronous instruction is not planned during the synchronous block, teachers will be available to students for help or clarification of assignments. Students will be required to attend additional synchronous instructional time if they are falling behind or having trouble mastering course standards. The three hour block of synchronous instruction availability for students will be determined after master scheduling is set.

TIME*	MONDAY-FRIDAY
7:30-10:30	Synchronous: Pre-scheduled Zooms, required and/or optional extra help, required check-ins and/or advisement with teacher.
Flexible	Asynchronous: Meet assignment deadlines

Example B

TIME*	MONDAY-FRIDAY
Flexible	Asynchronous: Meet assignment deadlines
11:30-2:30	Synchronous: Pre-scheduled Zooms, required and/or optional extra help, required check-ins and/or advisement with teacher.
